- CNFA implements the USAID-funded Farmer-to-Farmer Program in Moldova, Ukraine, Belarus, Georgia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Angola, Malawi, and Mozambique
- First FTF activities were implemented by CNFA in Moldova from 1996, in association with a larger Agribusiness Development Program.
- Current FTF contract began in October 2008, with a plan to conduct 125 volunteer assignments before October 2013.
