

# The Export-Import Bank of the United States (Ex-Im Bank)



Ex-Im Bank is the official export credit agency mandated by the Congress to support American exports and create U.S. jobs

### **Export Credit Insurance**



### Enables U.S. exporters to offer short- and medium-term credit directly to their creditworthy international buyers. Benefits:

- Reduces non-payment risks:
  - ✓ Commercial risk (related to foreign buyer)
    - Slow pay, currency devaluation, insolvency
  - ✓ Political risk (related to foreign buyer's government:
    - Cancellation of import license
    - Currency inconvertibility
    - War, insurrection, civil disobedience
    - Confiscation or expropriation of exported products
- Enables U.S. exporter to extend competitive credit terms to buyers
- > Helps U.S. suppliers exporting to new markets with more confidence



### Success Story: Miami, FL – Based Kimre, Inc.



Kimre, Inc. a maker of air pollution control filters used Ex-Im Bank's Short-Term Insurance to offer 60-day "open account" credit terms to new international customers in Europe. Benefits:

- Reduced nonpayment political&commercial risks in new export markets
- Replaced costly local bank financing & payment by Letter of Credit L/C
- > Enabled the U.S. exporter to offer credit to new European importers
- According *Kimre's* Controller Ms. Elizabeth Mosca: "Ex-Im Bank's Insurance has provided us with the ability to offer open account credit instead of L/C's, which are costly and time consuming. Second, the Insurance on our foreign receivables has enabled our bank to increase our credit lines which we needed to grow our business."



### **Loan Guarantees**



<u>Guaranteed Loans</u> are made by U.S. or international commercial banks to foreign buyers of U.S. products with an *unconditional* repayment guarantee from Ex-Im Bank

- Ex-Im Guarantee covers 85% of the U.S. content of the exported products
- U.S. or foreign banks often finance the 15% cash payment required from the buyer

Ex-Im Bank's guarantees help U.S. exporters secure competitive financing for their foreign buyers. Ex-Im guarantee term financing--generally up to 10 years--to creditworthy buyers in both the private and public sector, and finance local costs up to 30%. Benefits:

- Risk mitigation for a particular export-import transaction
- > Financing for international buyers of U.S. capital goods and related services
- More secure entry to and development of the new European emerging markets
- ➤ Flexible lender financing options, backed by Ex-Im guarantee, for buyers of U.S. capital goods & services to start medium & long-term projects with flexible repayment terms
- Coverage for 100% of political and commercial risks with no limits on transaction size





- U.S. Ex-Im Bank supported nearly \$85 million Loan Guarantees to finance Harris Corporation's project to manufacture and install a comprehensive broadcast network system.
- ➤ The Ioan was made by Societe Generale Bank to Radiocomunicatii Romania S.A. - RadioCom
- > Loan repayment term was for 10-years with a total term of 14.5-years.
- ➤ With Ex-Im Bank's Guarantee carrying the full faith and credit of the U.S. Government, Societe Generale Bank funded the loan at the lowest possible interest rates.
- > Ex-Im Bank also supported the financing of local costs equal to the OECD maximum of 15% of the contract price or \$12.8 million.



## Direct Loans (Fixed-Rate Term Financing for Foreign Buyers)



Ex-Im Bank provides fixed-rate financing -- up to 12 years in general and up to 18 years for renewable energy projects-- to creditworthy international buyers in both the private and public sector, and finance local costs up to 30%.

#### **Benefits:**

- Fixed-rate financing with interest rate set based on the Commercial Interest Reference Rates CIRR. (They are calculated monthly and are based on government bonds issued in the country's domestic market for the country's currency. In the case of the US dollar, the CIRR is based on the U.S. Treasury bond rate.)
- Coverage for 100% of commercial and political risks with no limits on transaction size
- > Financing of up to 30% of local costs in addition to the U.S. exports.

#### Requirements:

- Goods must be shipped from the U.S. or services must be provided by U.S. personnel.
- Min. 50% U.S. content that can only be financed up to max. 85% of the export price
- ➢ Buyer must meet Ex-Im Bank's credit standards: Positive Operating Profit (last 2 years), Positive Net Income (last 2 years), Positive Cash-Flow-From-Operations (latest year), Ioan amount can't exceed 40% of tangible net worth, Iow leverage a.s.o.



### Success Story: Environmental Export Financing Program



It's a program mandated in Ex-Im Bank's Charter for environmentally-beneficial exports, including energy efficiency, renewable energy, water & waste treatment, air pollution etc.

- > Ex-Im Bank has Environmental Standards and Guidelines applied to each project considered under its Loan and Guarantee Programs.
- Environmental Exports Program Consists of <u>pro-active</u> business development and enhancements to existing Ex-Im Bank Programs.
- Environmental projects are offered enhancements:
  - **❖** Maximum OECD repayment term for Long-Term Loans and Guarantees of 10-12 years after project completion
  - **❖** Capitalization of interest during construction
  - **❖** Up to 15% local cost support within the U.S. scope of supply
- RESULTS: Transactions approved under the Program grew from 10 in FY 1994, to a high of 68 in FY 2007, totaling over \$3 billion



## United States Trade and Development Agency (USTDA)



TDA is a federal agency funded by the Congress to help create U.S. jobs through the export of U.S. products for priority projects to advance economic growth in emerging markets.

# Feasibility Study Success Story Electronic Election Management System EMS Project

USTDA is providing \$344,422 to the Permanent Electoral Authority of Romania to support a feasibility study that will develop an integrated IT-based solution to improve the accuracy of voting.

The study will develop a high-level assessment and implementation plan combining technical, managerial, and institutional recommendations.

EEMS implementation considerably improves Romanian citizens' experience with the voting process and build a higher level of trust in election results.

# USTDA & Commercial Service Romania's Pilot Project Success Story Wish Motorola SCADA Water Management Project

USTDA is partnering with Motorola and one of the largest water companies in Romania, RAJA Constanta to conduct a water management pilot project focusing on the design and implementation of a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system.

The pilot project demonstrates SCADA system's capacity to reduce RAJA's operational and maintenance costs and monitor and control its water supply.

The success of this pilot project could encourage widespread adoption of these efficiency-improving U.S. technologies by other firms in Romania and neighbors.





# USTDA & Commercial Service Romania's Technical Assistance Success Story Integrated Network for Education and Technologies

USTDA is funding a \$366,841 technical assistance grant to the Ministry of Education, Research and Youth for the development of an Integrated Network for Education and Technologies (INET) project.

INET's design and implementation represent an upgrade to existing networks and IT infrastructure at schools, universities and research centers to help develop students' skills and satisfy growing needs of employers for improved innovation.

INET concluded with 5 initiatives: Broadband Through European Structural Fundis, Education Management Information System (EMIS), Virtual Library, Teachers' House and National Authority for Scientific Research (ANCS)
